Mezzo-Soprano Veena Akama-Makia will be a Jette Parker Artist at The Royal Opera House for 2023-25 seasons. For her 2022-2023 season, she will complete her final season as a Chicago Opera Theater/Chicago College of the Performing Arts at Roosevelt University Professional Diploma Candidate and Young Artist. In the Spring of 2023, she will make her role debut as Nancy in Albert Herring (Britten), as Wren 2 in The Life and Death(s) of Alan Turing (Chen), and as Kendra in the world premiere of The Cook-Off (Okpebohlo/Campbell). Last summer, Ms. Akama-Makia joined the San Francisco Opera's Merola Opera Program as a Young Artist, where she performed the role of Dritte Dame in Die Zauberflöte (Mozart) and was a soloist in the Merola Grand Finale. In the Spring of 2022, she made her COT debut as Tawny Betty in the World Premiere of *Quamino's Map* (Wallen/Brevoort) and the role of Tree Spirit in *The BeeKeeper* (Lu/Rourke) as part of COT's Vanguard Initiative. In the fall of 2021, she began her residency with COT by covering the role of Mercedes in performances of Carmen (Bizet) and the role of Ib in Becoming Santa Claus (Adamo). Ms. Akama-Makia has been honored with several awards, most recently being a 2023 Annapolis Opera Voice Competition Semi-finalist, a 2023 Pasadena Voice Competition Semi-finalist, a 2022 Encouragement Award Winner from Laffont Competition Illinois District, a 2022 Irene Dalis Vocal Competition Semi-finalist, a James Toland Vocal Competition Tier I Semi-finalist, and received the Virginia Cooper Maier Award in the 2022 Musicians Club of Women Vocal Competition.
